FORMAL DANCE ATTIRE LISTING

FOR ALL CLASSES, NO JEWELLERY IS ALLOWED AND HAIR MUST BE UP AND OFF THE FACE AND IN A PONY TAIL OR BUN (BALLET STUDENTS MUST HAVE A PROPER BUN!!) ANY DANCER NOT PREPARED WITH THE ATTIRE LISTED BELOW WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THEIR LESSON!!!

PRE-SCHOOL LEVEL AND BALLET/JAZZ COMBO CLASSES - (AGES 3 - 6)

- Sleeveless or short sleeved, scoop neck Polyester-cotton lycra*(PCL) leotard with matching skirt, pale pink.
- Pink soft ballet slipper with elastics and short pink socks (pink ballet tights may be worn in the winter season)
- For the jazz semester, the attire remains the same, including the shoes. You may switch to a black leotard but this is up to you as a parent.
- For the pre-school tap semester, you have the option of black, non marking, party shoes or black paten tap shoes.

JAZZ AND MUSICAL THEATRE ATTIRE - all dancers enrolled in the jazz programs are required to wear the following:

- Black bodysuit (any style), beige tights (convertible tights are recommended) and form fitted dance shorts
- Absolutely no tank tops, t-shirts, sweatshirts etc are allowed

Shoes - primary levels - black ballet slipper with elastic across instep

Jr. levels 1 and up - black split sole jazz shoes (any brand, and best fit)

TAP ATTIRE - same attire as the jazz listed above

Shoes - beginner tappers - black paten tap shoes - please replace ribbons with black elastic to avoid the laces coming undone during class

- Tap levels 2 and up - black split sole tap shoe (slip ons or lace ups - the best fit for your dancer)

*Please note that the tap shoes can not be too big as they will continue to fall off the dancers foot

HIP HOP ATTIRE - Dance pants, track pants, tank tops or dance tops are only allowed. Absolutely no jeans are allowed at any lesson.

- clean running shoes (preferably white only - for costume purposes) no outdoor or street shoes allowed.
- Your hair still must be up and out of your face!!!!

BOYS ATTIRE - Black pants or shorts, white t-shirt or tank top and appropriate footwear for chosen discipline

- No ball caps please (exception - hip hop classes)

BALLET ATTIRE - Correct ballet attire is expected at all lessons! Hair must be in a classical bun using hair nets and bobbie pins - no messy buns are allowed. If hair is not done properly, you will be asked to leave the lesson and not return until done so.

Below is your listing of attire for each level and must be abided by as it is the official grades syllabus uniform set out by the Royal Academy of Dance.

Pre-Primary and Primary Ballet Classes - Sleeveless, or short sleeve, scoop neck Polyester-cotton lycra*(PCL) leotard with matching skirt, pale pink. Pink soft ballet slippers with elastics and short pink socks. Leotard: Mondor styles. Skirt also available from Mondor.

Ballet Grades 1 and 2 - Sleeveless scoop neck PCL leotard, NAVY, with matching elastic belt. Pink soft ballet slippers with elastic and short pink socks Mondor #167. Leotard: Mondor style #1635 (no shorts or skirts permitted) **Character attire is also required - see next page**

Ballet Grades 3 to 5 - Sleeveless pinch front PCL leotard, NAVY, with matching elastic belt. Pink convertible nylon ballet tights Mondor style #314 or #319. Pink soft ballet slippers with pink elastics. Leotard: Mondor style #1633 (no shorts or skirts permitted) **Character attire is also required - see next page**

Major Levels - (intermediate foundation and up) - Black spaghetti strapped bodysuit, convertible pink nylon tights, pink soft leather slippers with ribbons - no split sole shoes allowed, pointe shoes (to be brought to all lessons if approved by the instructor - the dancer will be notified if they are ready to start pointe work) **(no shorts or skirts permitted)**

CHARACTER ATTIRE REQUIRED FOR BALLET GRADES 1 THROUGH 5 *Please note that this attire should be brought to all of your lessons throughout the year.

Character Skirt - should be full circle or gathered (the former style is preferred) The ideal material is a heavy polyester gaberdine or a heavy polyester cotton blend. The preferred color is black. Ribbon trim of the instructors choice at the bottom edge of the skirt in colors complimentary to the students leotard should be added. (Colors preferred are red, navy and green) Skirt length should fall between the bottom of the knee and mid-calf (usually measure 2-3inched below the dancers knee.

-these skirts are also available to purchase at some dancewear shops (listed below)

Character Shoes - both leather or canvas top character shoes with pink elastic across the instep are acceptable

Grades 1 and 2 - a low heel is required

Grades 3 to 5 - dancers have the option of a 1-1/4" Cuban heel if desired

Pink elastic is to be worn across the instep

BALLET EXAMS - It will be up to the instructor's discretion as to the participation in the Royal Academy examinations. Parents and students will be approached prior to the deadline of examination fees that are due of their qualifications for examinations.
